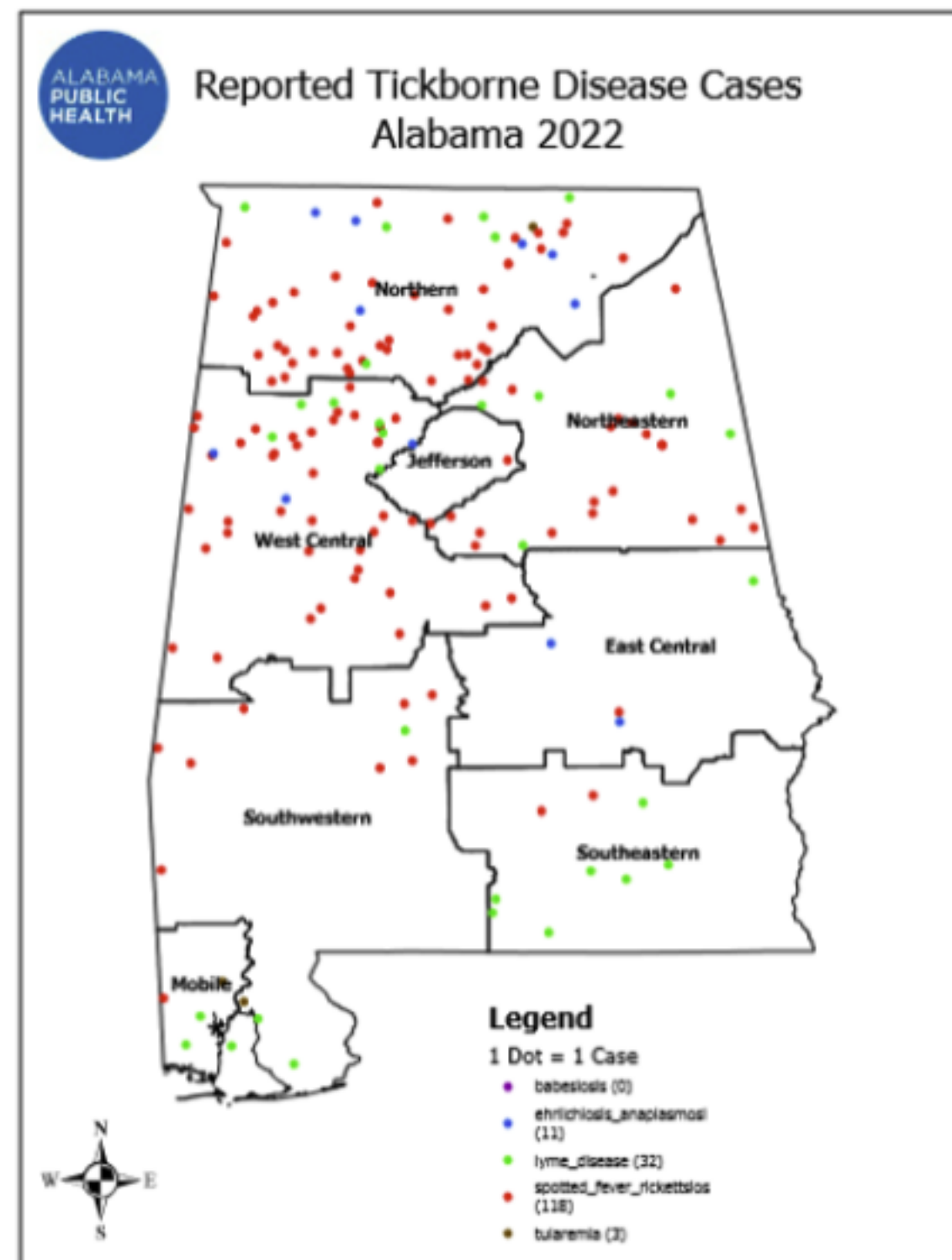

Locations of exposure: Arkansas (1), Georgia (1), North Carolina (2), Tennessee (1) and unable to be determined (2). Cases were reported by Clay (1), Hillsborough (1), Jackson (1), Miami-Dade (1) Polk (1), Putnam (1), and Sumter (1) counties.

**Florida acquired acute Lyme disease:** Nineteen cases with an onset date in 2012 have been reported. Cases were exposed in Alachua (2), Citrus (1), Dixie (1), Flagler (1), Hillsborough (1), Holmes (1), Jefferson (1), Leon (1), Manatee (1), Orange (1), Pinellas (1), Putnam (3), Seminole (1), St. Lucie (1), Suwannee (1), and Volusia (1) counties.
